Exhibitor Rules and Regulations:

7. The MNS welcomes exhibitors because they are essential to keeping neurologists informed of new and better products and services for their practices. However, exhibits, products, booth backdrops, and promotional materials must be factual, dignified, and tasteful. They must provide helpful product and service information. These standards apply to all product-specific promotional material submitted to MNS programs. Companies exhibiting at the MNS annual meeting must not reference their participation in any advertising or promotion. Exhibiting is not an endorsement or approval of the company or its products or services by the Association or any of its subsidiaries, councils, commissions, or agencies. The MNS may accept or reject any application to exhibit at its sole discretion. It has full and final authority to interpret, amend, or supplement these Guidelines, Rules, and Regulations. Exhibitors, by applying for and accepting exhibit space, agree to abide by these Guidelines, Rules, and Regulations, as well as any that may be adopted in the future.

Eligibility to Exhibit & Sponsor: MNS reserves the right to determine the eligibility of all exhibitors and sponsorship applicants. MNS's acceptance of an exhibitor/sponsor does not constitute an endorsement of the firm's products or services. Applications deemed ineligible by MNS will be returned with a complete refund for exhibit space and/or sponsorship fees.

MNS will assign exhibit space on a first-come, first-served basis. Exhibitors' location preferences are for guidance only and are not guaranteed. MNS reserves the right to reassign booth space or rearrange the floor plan at any time before or during the meetings.

Exhibitors may not assign or sublet the whole or any part of the space to others. Space assignments are based on payment. If an exhibitor was in the downstairs location last year, they will be assigned to the upstairs exhibitor area this year, and vice versa.

Exhibit Space & Sponsorship Payment Schedule: Fees are in U.S. dollars and may be paid by check. Full payment must accompany the Application and Contract for Exhibit Space. Applications/contracts received without full payment are deemed to be incomplete.

- **PROTECTION OF THE BUILDING**—Signs or displays may not be taped, posted, thumbtacked, nailed, or otherwise affixed to any part of the venue outside of each exhibitor's rented exhibit space.
- The Exhibitor and its employees, agents, guests, or visitors release MNS and its representatives from all claims, liabilities, and expenses arising from injury, death, or property damage related to the Exhibitor's use of the hotel or convention center facilities, equipment, or booth. The Exhibitor also agrees to indemnify and hold harmless MNS and its representatives for any such incidents.

Notification of cancellation or reduction of exhibit space and/or sponsorship must be received by MNS in writing. For refunds: If MNS receives written notice of cancellation at least 45 days before the meetings open, a refund will be issued, subject to a \$250 administrative fee. If notice is received less than 45 days before the meetings open, no refund will be issued. If MNS cancels due to the Exhibitor's or Sponsor's default or violation, the same refund policy applies.

MNS is not liable for any damage or expenses incurred by the Exhibitor or Sponsor if the meetings are delayed, interrupted, or not held as scheduled. If, for any reason beyond MNS's control, sessions are not held, MNS may credit the amount paid to a similar event scheduled for the following year. Exhibit space not claimed or occupied before the meetings open, and for which no special arrangements have been made, may be resold or reassigned by MNS. In such cases, MNS is not obligated to provide any refund or assign other space to the exhibitor.

Official Contact: The Company Contact listed on the Application and Contract for Exhibit Space shall act on behalf of the exhibitor and/or sponsor in all negotiations. The on-site contact shall be responsible for all exhibit/sponsorship materials, equipment, and personal items.

- **AMENDMENTS**—These Rules and Regulations may be amended and are to be enforced as interpreted by the MNS. Any situation not covered by these rules and regulations is subject to the MNS's determination.

This Contract is the entire agreement between the parties. It replaces all other written and oral agreements about its subject matter. Even if local law allows oral modifications to this written Contract, such changes will not be binding. I understand that my company's violations of any of these regulations are subject to penalties. Penalties may be recommended by MNS, including possible exclusion from future MNS events.
